5. _____ Proverbs 3:5-6 – Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
6. _____ Proverbs 15:1 – A soft answer turneth away wrath; but grievous words stir up anger.
7. _____ Isaiah 9:6 – For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.
8. _____ Isaiah 40:8 – The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.
9. _____ Nahum 1:7 – The Lord is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.
10. _____ Matthew 4:10 – Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written. Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
11. _____ Matthew 5:16 – Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
12. _____ Luke 6:37 – Judge not, and ye shall not be judged; condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven.
